Entry Restricted Information

The event is restricted to 36 boats. This is to provide two racing heats to a scored race with 20 boats on the line under EORS heat management. Restricting the entries is to increase the sailing time for competitors in the event.

Per the NOR those competitors outside the US Authority and those members of the US EC12 Class who are nationals of another country in the event shall be restricted to 24 boats. Members of the US EC12 Class will be restricted to 12 boats. However, should the total entries for the event fall below 36 boats; the US will be allowed to fill the entries to the 36 boat restriction.

This consideration provides the international community priority in the event. As many of you know, the US can draw 50 boats to a major event. It is felt unfair for this kind of event and hope other countries hosting the Morgan-Black will see it similarly.

US EC12 Class entries will be open to all members with registered boats. However, the competitor ranking system used for entries to the National Championship will be used to fill the restricted entries for this event.

Because this will create a sizable Standby List, entry will be closed to all on September 1, 2009. At that time the entry list for the event will be firm and US competitors can make their plans. Cancellations to the firmed list will be filled till the end of the month. At that time all processes will be completed for the event and the names listed.

The entries to the event will be posted on this website, as they are received.

The international community may enter at any time from now to the closing date of the event. US members cannot enter before May 1, 2009. Members who plan to enter this event may send an email to the Class Secretary of your interest and it will be posted. However, it is not an official entry.
